It typically does not gravitate to love stories, but I am glad I decided to give this a try. Traherne clearly has the patience, tact and imagination of a natural educator. The plot seemed plodding and predictable and the character's mental and emotional dialog was limiting and repetitive.

It is that patience that is the width of Antillean life, and the secret is not to let a forgotten, insomniac night; History and elemental awe are always our early beginning, because the fate of poetry is to fall in love with the world, in spite of History.
