Influence of a cold front upon the onset of Meniere's disease in Toyama, Japan. There is no dry season in Munich, however mean monthly precipitation totals varied from 46mm in February to mm in July. We analyzed the possible relationship Vertigo Diary atmospheric pressure and other meteorological Vertigo Diary with the onset of MD vertigo episodes in order to determine whether atmospheric pressure changes play a role in the occurrence of MD episodes.

Any ambient pressure increase raised the probability for an episode during the study. Because of temporal overlap between some of the Vertigo Diary, some meteorological data points contribute repeatedly to the analyses. July was the warmest month in Munich, with an average temperature of 18°C. Lower AIC indicates better fit. On the basis of this finding, it is conceivable that the prevalence of MD episodes is illustrated over the first days after inclusion in the study.
