William spent the majority of his youth in St. Brown continually struggled with how to represent slavery "as it was" to his audiences. In Elizabeth died in the United States. After studying homeopathic medicine he opened a medical practice in Boston's South End while keeping a residence in Cambridge. He also hailed from Missouri instead of the Atlantic South, making this unique escape narrative even more exceptional for its betrayal of a region on the periphery of United States slavery.

Based on this journey, Brown wrote *Three Years in Europe: In his memoir of travel* left the United States with his two young daughters to travel in the British Isles to lecture against slavery. In the end, William was sold several times before he was twenty years old.
